ACCOMMODATION

• The term **accommodation** refers to a room, building or place which provides shelter for a person to stay, work, sleep or live.

TYPES OF ACCOMMODATION

- Hotel: The hotel has a mínimum of ten rooms. The majority of the rooms must be single or double.
- Motel: Hotel located by the road. Such facilities must offer parking space.
- **Camping:** Guarded facilities where guests can stay in the tents, cars or caravans.
- **Boutique hotel:** Elegant, luxurious facilities, often located in historic buildings.
- **Bungalow:** Small holiday houses, usually wooden, with a roof covered with palm leaves in exotic countries.
- **Guesthouse:** A private house offering accommodations to paying guests.
